Dear Third Grade Parents:

After attending a teacher's Open House Event at the Andy Warhol Museum, the third grade teachers submitted grant proposals for education programs funded by the Grable Foundation. We are pleased to announce that we were both awarded grants for our proposals! Our grants include an educational program related to *The Arts of Jean Cocteau* exhibition and selected areas of the museum's permanent collection, busing to and from the museum, and a follow-up outreach program at St. Louise. We have met with the Assistant Curator of Education to plan our visit and have chosen to view the work of Jean Cocteau (1889-1963) who was a writer, graphic artist, designer, and filmmaker. The children will learn how to read a portrait and how to gain meaning from art. They will view texture rubbings, illustrated letters, and study the use of line in works of art. They will see how Cocteau's film "Beauty and The Beast" is connected to Disney's animated version of the film and we will also view Andy Warhol's multidisciplinary approach to artwork. Included in the tour will be Warhol's flower rooms, time capsules, and the opportunity to experience his "Silver Clouds". They will study Warhol's use of screen-printing and through the outreach follow-up program later this year; the students will make their own screen prints in the style of Andy Warhol. The works of Cocteau and Warhol that we have selected for our visit will allow the children to explore creativity. **Our field trip to the Andy Warhol Museum is scheduled for, January 26, 2001.** The bus will leave St. Louis by 9:00 a.m. and return in time for lunch in our classrooms by 12:30. **Please complete and return the attached permission slip by Friday, January 19<sup>th</sup>.**
